- 1. "The Lake County Sheriff's Office will not hire or promote anyone who may have contact with inmates and shall not enlist the services of any contractor who may have contact with inmates who;
- (a) Has engaged in sexual abuse in a prison, jail, lockup, community confinement facility, juvenile facility or other institution (as defined in 42 U.S.C.1997);
- (b) Has been convicted of engaging or attempting to engage in sexual activity in the community facilitated by force, overt or implied threats of force, or coercion, or if the victim did not consent or was unable to consent refuse: or
- (c) Has been civilly or administratively adjudicated to have engaged in the activities described in paragraph (1) of this section."

"The Lake County Sheriff's Office will ask all applicants and employees who may have contact with inmates directly about previous misconduct described in paragraph (1) (above) of this section in written applications or interviews for hiring or promotions and in any interviews or written self evaluations conducted as part of reviews of current employees (background checks). It is your obligation to disclose any such misconduct. By my signature below, I am stating that I have not been involved in any of the activities described in paragraph (1).
